

VACANCY! Volunteers NEEDED

Do you want to help make Battlefield the best place to live in Greene County? Are you willing to devote some time and energy to see that desire fulfilled? Then this is your opportunity. Due to a resignation for health reasons, we have an opening in Ward 2 for Alderman. This two-year term for the City Board of Aldermen was filled during the April 2009 general election and will be open for re-election in April 2011.

What are the details?

- You must have lived in Ward 2 for at least 12 months and be at least 18 years old. Ward 2 boundaries are generally south of Weaver Road; east of Old Wire Road; north of Elm Street; west of Aspen Drive and including Battlefield Estates. If you are not sure if you live in Ward 2, please call City Hall at 883-5840 during normal business hours.
- Meetings are the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of each month beginning at 7 PM and typically last approximately two hours. Board packets are delivered to your home on Friday before the meeting for study which should take approximately one hour. On occasion, other meetings or activities will be scheduled that require your attendance.
- If you are interested, please come to City Hall before February 19th and fill out an application. You will be contacted by the mayor for a personal interview during the week after. The new alderman will be appointed at the March 2nd regular meeting of the Board of Aldermen.
- Experience in politics is not necessary as this is a non-partisan position. There are several opportunities for training offered by the City and the Missouri Municipal League.
